



When installing EventCAD onto a new machine, you may want to copy over the **data** from the older machine in order to see the drawings that you were previously working on.

You can do so by copying 2 folders which are on your **(C:) drive**, then **Program Files** (or **Program Files (x86)** on a 64-bit machine). The folders are called **ECBin** and **ECData**.

You need to **Copy** these folders, and **Paste** them in the same location (i.e. On the (C:) drive / Program Files..).

You can try copying the data file only (**ECData**) and using the latest program, but the two may not be compatible. If this is the case, you then have to decide to either start from scratch with the **latest program** but with a **blank** database, or keep using your **existing program** and database.
