



## How do I set up port forwarding on the BT Business Hub 3

You will also need to set up port forwarding on your router.

Each router can have a slightly different configuration so I suggest looking it up on Google if you are unsure.

Below are the instructions for the BT Business Hub 3

To set up **Port Forwarding** on your BT Business Hub 3 simply:

1. Open your web browser and browse to **http://btbusinesshub.home** to open the Hub Manager.
2. Select **Settings**.
3. When prompted, enter the **admin password** and click **OK**.

Click on **Advanced Settings** and then **Continue to Advanced Settings**.

1. Now select **Port Forwarding** and then **Supported Applications**.
2. Click **Add a New Game or Application**.
3. Enter **Application** name as **TSS**  
This will describe the port that you are adding and will also be used to identify the name of the port rule as listed in the drop down.
4. Select **NO** on the copy existing game/application
5. Enter the port number of **3050** into each of the port boxes, click **Add**.
6. Click **Apply** once all ports have been added.
7. Go to **Configuration**.
8. Choose **TSS** from the **Game or Application** drop down list.
9. Select your device from the **Device** drop down list or select user **Defined IP Address**.
10. If using defined IP, enter the appropriate **IP** in the box provided.
11. Click **Add**.
